The proposal should make the case for which one would be appropriate in your team's professional opinion. The City, as CEQA lead agency is supportive of either document, understanding that the extent of the changes to the zoning code will help dictate which document would be appropriate.</p> <p>An acceptable approach is to show a contingency scope & budget for the higher of the two CEQA documents, as long as the total fee, including the contingency, is within the overall not-to-exceed range listed in the RFP.</p>
