The female passenger was identified as 21 year old Adrianna Chavez of Orosi, California. The 13 year old passenger has been identified as Alejandro Chavez, also from the City of Orosi. Next of kin has been notified.

Tulare, CA:

On Saturday, July 8, 2017 at 1526 hours, the Tulare Police Department dispatch center received a 911 call regarding an injury traffic collision involving 3 vehicles at the intersection of Hillman Street and Cartmill Avenue in Tulare, CA.

Officers of the Tulare Police Department and medical personnel arrived on scene and located two people with serious visible injuries. Both were transported to local area hospitals where the 13 year old male passenger succombed to his injuries. The second passenger, a 21 year old female, is in grave condition.

Based on the investigation by Tulare Police Department Traffic Unit, Suspect) Servando Lopez Garcia was placed under arrest for the above listed charges.
